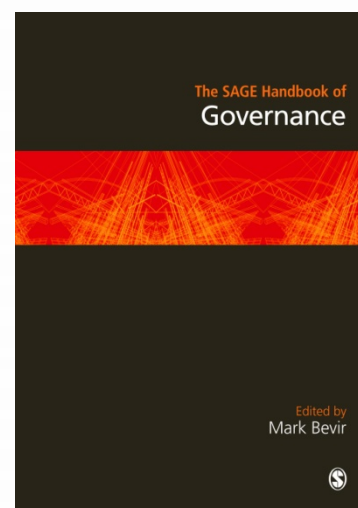


The SAGE Handbook of Governance
